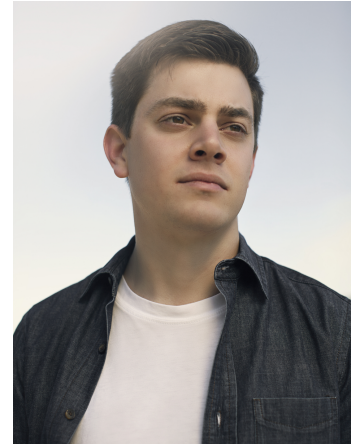

BIOGRAPHY

David Scotton was placed for adoption in Louisiana after his mother, Melissa Coles, left an Indiana abortion clinic in 1993. At the age of 19, David decided he wanted to meet his biological family he's never known to thank them for giving him life and choosing adoption. David is the subject of *I Lived on Parker Avenue* (ILOPA), produced by Louisiana Right to Life, Joie De Vivre Media and Philip Braun Productions, LLC, which shows that journey to meet his birth parents.

The ILOPA documentary was an official 2017 selection for the Docuslate Film Festival in Los Angeles, California, and official 2018 selection for the Christian Worldview Film Festival in Franklin, Tennessee. Adoption groups across the United States have endorsed ILOPA, including the National Council for Adoption.

David toured the film at over 100+ events across the country and has made appearances on nationally syndicated radio and television shows. In January 2018, Louisiana's 2 sitting United States Senators and 4 sitting United States Congressmen hosted a Capitol Hill Screening of ILOPA. ILOPA premiered in Louisiana at the Governor's Mansion with Louisiana Governor John Bel Edwards, and released online March 8, 2018.

In 2017, David was nominated and selected by the Louisiana Institute for Children in Families as a Louisiana Angel in Adoption, honoring him and his family for working to better the lives of Louisiana children through foster care and adoption.

David also formerly worked on Capitol Hill for United States Congressman Bill Cassidy and United States Senator David Vitter. David graduated in 2016 from Louisiana State University with a degree in Mass Communication and Jesuit High School in 2012, with the Culture of Life and the Very Reverend Father Pedro Arrupe Awards.

David is also an attorney in New Orleans, practicing all types of business and commercial litigation, but is now in the process of also creating his own adoption practice. David lives in New Orleans with his wife Piper.
